HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY

A Pastor was visiting a family and during the conversation, the 6 year old girl asked her mother, “Mom, what is the colour of God's eyes?” The mother was perplexed and looked at the Pastor for help. “It is the same colour of your eyes,” said the Pastor. The child was so happy to know that they share the same qualities.

Holy Trinity is a mystery when we think of it in theological and philosophical terms. But it is a mystery God revealed on human experiential level. The letter to the Hebrews says, “God has spoken in the past of our fathers through the prophets, in many different ways, although never completely; but in our times he has spoken definitely to us through his Son.” So it is a mystery unfolded at Divine initiation through his son Jesus and continues to do so in the Holy Spirit. God is love. He, who lives in love, lives in God. We should be happy to know that we are also part of the mystery of the Holy Trinity.
