BECOMING FOOD FOR THE WORLD

When Jesus took the bread, blessed it, broke it, and gave it to the disciples, he summarized in these gestures his own life. Jesus is chosen from all eternity, blessed in the Jordan river, broken on the cross, and given as bread to the world. Before the institution of the Eucharist, Jesus reminded the significance of the event, by washing the feet of the disciples and giving the commandment to love one another. Being Chosen, blessed, broken and given is the sacred journey of the Son of God, Jesus the Christ.

When we take bread, bless it, break it, and give it with the words “this is the Body of Christ” we express our commitment to make our lives conform to the life of Christ. We too want to live as people chosen, blessed and broken and thus become food for the world. By eating the Body of Christ, we become the living Christ and we are enabled to discover our own choosiness and blessedness, acknowledged our own brokenness and trust that we are called to live for others. MISSION, PEACE, AND DEVELOPMENT

Many thanks to Nina Chung, who was our guest speaker at our June meeting. A former Holy Cross parishioner, Nina has been living in Malindi, Kenya where husband Paul has been working as a VSO volunteer. Based in the U.K., VSO is a well-respected NGO that accepts highly qualified volunteers for overseas service. Much of Nina's work was facilitating the sponsorship of 30 young people in the nearby village of Gaetti. Nina and Paul contacted friends and families back home to support the sponsorship of these children. Education in Kenya is free only at the primary level.

While we can no longer deliver used eyeglasses to Nicaragua, MPD will deliver any glasses that are dropped off at church, to local optical outlets which in turn will forward them to the developing world.

DID YOU KNOW?

Holy Communion—Both forms

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches (#1390) that Christ is present in a sacramental way under each form—the bread and the wine—and that receiving only the bread (the host) brings all the grace of the Eucharist. At the same time, "the sign of communion is more complete when given under both kinds, since in that form the sign of the Eucharistic meal appears more clearly." (Receiving both forms in common practice in the Eastern Rites.) "Intinction" is receiving Communion under both forms by dipping the host in the chalice; this practice is discouraged in many dioceses because the sign value of dunking is weaker than drinking in response to the mandate "Take and drink..."
