Dear Friends,  
 The Church celebrates today the solemnity of the Holy Trinity. This Solemnity reminds the Church of its responsibility of taking part in the creative work of God. Remember the mission command of Jesus, to “baptize in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit” is an invitation to the Church to create a new world—the Kingdom of God.
