Pastor's Column...

CORPUS CHRISTI (BODY OF CHRIST)

Today's celebration, the Solemnity of The Body and Blood of Christ is an opportunity for us to focus on the Mass and the Eucharist.

Historically, there was only one sacrifice of Christ on the cross. Sacramentally, Jesus is sacrificed on the cross as often as the Eucharistic is celebrated. The Eucharist is the Lord's dying gift for us at the Last Supper. The Eucharist is Jesus Christ within us. The Israelites ate "manna" in the wilderness on their journey towards the Promised Land. But they were physically hungry, thirsty and died. It was in this context that Jesus said, "I am the bread of life." It is a strange teaching. It is the humble way of giving Himself for us in order that we may have life in abundance. If we become aware of the Eucharistic gift of Jesus, we can only humbly say, "Lord, I am not worthy to receive you, but only say the word and I shall be healed."
