### *Pastor’s Column...*

#### FATHER’S DAY

A bit of food for thought for father’s day: Fathers are not what they used to be. A study conducted in some U.S. cities some years ago revealed that fathers spend an average of eight minutes a day talking with their children. In industrial society the home is becoming a dormitory, and the father does not work there. His place in the lives of his children is becoming less and less. He brings home the money, but the children have no knowledge of or enthusiasm for his work. And to this the vogue in psychology for blaming all one’s own ills on one’s parents, and the father is exiled even further.

In the New Testament the image of father is far removed both from the stern Victorian father and the absentee father of today. It is full of tenderness and affection. In the story of the Prodigal Son (Lk 15), for example, the father rushed out to greet his wayward son, clasped him in his arms and kissed him. Jesus knew himself totally loved by his Father, “As the

Father has loved me, so I have loved you" (Jn 15:9). The fact that we can even *imagine* what this was like means that the image of father is not dead in us.

"My name is Kaitlyn. I'm a youth rep at Development and Peace – the official development agency of the Catholic Church in Canada, and the Canadian member of Caritas International. Inspired by Gospel values..." That's how Holy Cross parishioner Kaitlyn Duthie-Kannikkatt began her speech on Parliament Hill last Tuesday urging government to pass Bill C-300. If passed, the bill would among other things, put in place standards that Canadian mining and oil companies must follow when operating in developing
