#### MISSION, PEACE, AND DEVELOPMENT

To accommodate members' schedules, our MPD meeting has been pushed back one week. We will now meet Tuesday, January 12 at 7:30 pm in room A. We will decide how to distribute the funds raised from the sale of African AIDS Angels to the projects in South Africa and Zambia.

**ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP – Support KAIROS:** KAIROS is an ecumenical Christian organization that includes the Catholic Church. It works ardently for peace, ecological justice and the advancement of human rights in the world, including countries where there is destruction of the environment and great suffering at the hands of irresponsible corporations and corrupt leaders. As St. Augustine wrote, “In the absence of justice, what is sovereignty but organized robbery?” The government of Canada is facing mounting criticism for withdrawing CIDA support of KAIROS in the face of an exceptionally positive 35 year track record and support from all levels of the funding process with the exception of the Prime Minister and his cabinet. **Tip of the Week:** Contact your MP to join the mounting criticism of the denial of CIDA funding to KAIROS.
