THE FEAST OF THE HOLY TRINITY

The Feast of the Holy Trinity reminds us that God is a family of love. We are dealing here not just with some terrible abstract theological doctrine. What scripture reveals to us is a unity of three real persons. Of course, to try to understand fully how one God can be three Persons is not really possible for us. There are two extremes to be avoided: 1) Breaking our head trying to understand how one God can be three persons. 2) Saying, “Oh, it is a mystery” and not bother to have any understanding at all. (Fr. Frank Doyle SJ). St. Paul makes the mystery of Holy Trinity an experimental one whenever he greets the different communities or churches. *The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you.* Let us make the sign of the cross with this simple and profound understanding.
